

## Oak Cottage

The neighbouring building on plot no. 412+, described as a House and Garden, was also owned by John Tilley, the owner of the building, but was occupied by Charles Budd.

The 1841 Census lists Charles Budd, an agricultural labourer aged 40, living in Hide Street with his wife and seven children, three of whom were also agricultural labourers, including eleven year old Jane and nine year old Edward.

Now called Oak Cottage the property is a Grade 2 listed building. It has been surveyed by Dr Annabelle Hughes who said it was originally timber-framed with an estimated build date in the second quarter of the 1600s and "*although humble it had good head height and an original stack*".
