

Hyde Farm and Hovel

This hovel is the only building that remains of the former Hyde Farm. The photograph was taken in 1987 shortly before the roof was retiled, the open side enclosed and a new opening made on the opposite side. It is still used for storage.

A new house now stands to the east of the hovel. The northern part of the plot is the access to the back of the Hyde Square shops from the north. These now occupy the land where the barn (plot no. 428) once stood, as well as the northern part of plot no. 430. The pond shown on the tithe map is the car park for Hyde Square.
